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To Surf Life Saving Members,

The **Course Assessor Course** is surf lifesaving's Assessor requirements for anyone who wishes to be part of the Assessing network. This course teaches you how to plan and organise, assess competence and participate in assessment validation an assessment.

*TAAASS401B Plan and organize assessment, TAAASS402B Assess Competence and TAAASS404B Participate in assessment validation* will be delivered over three day sessions. The provider of the course provides each participant with the skills and knowledge to successfully assess surf life saving awards.

Your assessment is both theoretically (written questions) and practical. Evaluation of your competency is assessed by qualified club or Branch trainer/s and peer assessment from each skills session.

When completed the Assessment Activity workbook is returned to the Course Facilitator for marking. Upon the successful conclusion of the course and assessment you are to become an assessor in the awards in which you are a trainer for, after a form 14 has been raised and processed.
